Reflection by Rev. Leonard N. Peterson

Reading I: Amos 6: 1a, 4-7

The idle rich are not blamed by the prophet for their pleasure-seeking, but for not noticing or caring about the pending collapse of "Joseph", meaning Israel.

Reading II: I Timothy 6: 11-16

Paul instructs Timothy on how he is to behave as the pastor of a flock. He is to remember most of all about how Jesus kept the faith in His Father as He faced His passion and death in the reign of Pilate.

The Gospel: Luke 16: 19-31

Here is one of Luke's "example stories." The question comes to the five brothers of the rich man and to us: Will they (and we) observe the teachings of the Old Testament and of Jesus about care for the needy around us? Will they (and we) even notice them?
